**Conditional Pass-Through Covered Bond Programme**

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This second supplement (the "**Second Supplement**") is the second supplement to the base prospectus dated 23 July 2014 (the "**Original Base Prospectus**") as supplemented by the first supplement date 23 September 2014 (the "**First Supplement**" and together with the Original Base Prospectus, the "**Base Prospectus**") of the Euro 5,000,000,000 Conditional Pass-Through Covered Bond Programme (the "**Programme**") of NIBC Bank N.V. (the "**Issuer**") and is prepared to update and amend the Base Prospectus and is supplemental to, forms part of and should be read in conjunction with the Base Prospectus, with any documents incorporated by reference therein, which, in relation to any Notes that are the subject of Final Terms, must be read and construed together with the relevant Final Terms. Terms defined in the Base Prospectus shall have the same meaning in this Supplement, unless specified otherwise.

This document is an amendment and a supplement to the Base Prospectus within the meaning of article 16 of Directive 2003/71/EC including Directive 2010/73/EU (the "**PD Amending Directive**") (the "**Prospectus Directive**"). This Second Supplement has been approved by the Dutch Authority for the Financial Markets (*Stichting Autoriteit Financiële Markten*, the "**AFM**"), which is the Dutch competent authority for the purpose of the Prospectus Directive and relevant implementing measures in the Netherlands, as a supplemental prospectus issued in compliance with the Prospectus Directive, Commission Regulation EC No. 809/2004 (the "**Prospectus Regulation**") and relevant implementing measures in the Netherlands for the purpose of giving information with regard to the issue of Notes under the Programme.

## CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE BASE PROSPECTUS

This Second Supplement is prepared in connection with:

- (A) the revision of the Issuers credit rating outlook from negative to stable by Standard & Poor's Credit Market Services Europe Limited ("**Standard & Poor's**") as set out in the press release issued by Standard & Poor's on 4 November 2014 (the "**Press Release**").

The above under (A) qualifies as significant new factor relating to the information included in the Base Prospectus set forth on page 76, which is capable of affecting the assessment of any Notes to be issued.

This Second Supplement is supplemental to, forms part of and should be read in conjunction with, the Base Prospectus. Terms defined in this Second Supplement shall have the same meaning in the Base Prospectus, unless specified otherwise.

To the extent that there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this Second Supplement or any statement incorporated by reference into the Base Prospectus, and (b) any other statement in or incorporated by reference in the Base Prospectus, the statements under (a) above will prevail.

The following amendments are made to the text of the Base Prospectus.

1. In chapter 5 "NIBC BANK N.V.", page 76, paragraph 3.5 "Ratings", the following wording in the second row, fourth column of the table shall be deleted:

"Negative"

and shall be replaced with:

"Stable".

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
